

# Smith Family Emergency Kit Checklist



It's hard to think clearly during an emergency so the last thing you want to do is leave something important behind. Use this checklist to gather essential items and prepare today for what might happen tomorrow.

\*The Smith family when they received notice of an evacuation alert, they went into action and gathered all of the bins, ready to load into their vehicle.

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## IN CASE OF EMERGENCY, HAVE THESE ITEMS READY - 10 MINUTES TO PACK & GO

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| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Food and water</b><br>Pre-prepared bin of food & water jugs - located in food storage room   | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>First aid kit</b> - Check in camping bin<br>Includes epi-pen for mom and copy of prescription, plus necessary meds safe for adults & children.  |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Camping bin</b><br>Includes Jet boil portable cooking stove, cookware, cooking utensils, garbage bags, etc for family of 5. This is packed strategically to be a grab and go, allowing the Smith family the option for the camping gear to double as an evac friendly bin  | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>72-Hour Kit</b><br>Contains toiletries, feminine supplies, tweezers, nail clippers, toilet paper, whistle, mirror, flashlight, candle, Firestarter, tube tent, etc. *The Smith family has a pre-built 72 hour kit from Briden Solutions, built for a family of 5. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Clothing</b><br>Change of clothes for each person, rain gear, winter gear, footwear, towels  | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Devices</b><br>Cell phone, charging cords, laptop, portable charger   |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Kid assignments</b><br>Son: grab pillow, blanket & takes shopping bag and fills with clothes & important keepsakes.<br>*The Smith family practiced evacuating so Son knows what to grab independently at age 14.<br>Daughter: grab pillow and blanket. Instructed to grab her favorite toy and mom or son assists with packing clothes (72 hours worth). | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Emergency binder</b><br>Birth certificate, driver's license, Alberta Health card, will, bank records, marriage license, cash in small denominations   |
| <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Personal items - if time permits</b><br>Mom: Photo albums stored in living room<br>Dad: Small box of childhood keepsakes, kept by his bedside  | <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Pete the Cat</b><br>Food, bedding, supplies   |
